All lot owners are asked to continue to take pride in the aesthetic presentation of your lot by following the Association Covenants. If you have questions regarding the Ashton Pointe Governing Documents or Johnston's City Codes/Ordinances, please contact Shelly for clarification. The following are a few reminders:

- **City Code 105.05 provides details pertaining to open burning in Johnston. Please ensure that you are in compliance with the code and consider wind direction so that neighbors are not disturbed by your activity.**
- **Garbage/Recycling containers, lawn/garden equipment and building materials must be stored out of public view.**
- **Tents, trailers, boats, etc. may not be placed within public view for more than a cumulative of seven (7) days in any calendar year.**
- **If you are planning ANY exterior addition or structural alteration to your home, you are required to submit plans to the Board of Directors/ Architectural Committee for review PRIOR TO beginning the project.**

Concern has been expressed recently about use of Home Owner email addresses. Please be respectful of privacy and not use neighbor information for solicitation, sales or other non-association issues.
